

LOCATIONS TO GET LIGHTING

Town Board Signs Contract for Street Lights at Leetonia, Kelly Lake, Carson Lake

Street lighting at Leetonia, Carson Lake and Kelly Lake, demanded by residents of these communities for several years, will be provided within the near future through a contract signed today with the Minnesota Power & Light company, Chairman Monti of the Town of Stunts board said today.

Negotiations for the service have been carried on some time and the terms that were agreed upon today will make it possible for the town board to satisfy the requests of residents in Kelly Lake, Carson Lake and Leetonia at a very nominal cost, it was stated. The system will be installed by the company and the town board will pay a service charge of less than \$70 a month.

Another accomodation planned by the town board this winter is protection of township day laborers while they are being transported to and from work in outlying districts, Chairman Monti said:

"We feel that township laborers should not be compelled to freeze riding on open trucks to and from work, sometimes a distance of several miles, in the bitter cold of winter. In addition to their suffering they are so numb when they arrive at the place of work that it takes them a couple of hours to thaw out before they are ready to go to work. We are going to give town employes sheltered transportation in cold weather hereafter, and we feel that this will benefit the older men who suffer most from cold."
