# SCHOOLS OPEN IN TWO WEEKS

Teaching Force of the Hibbing Schools This Year Will Number 75—Several Additions Necessary on Account of the Six New Location Schools.

Board of Education Will Call for Bids for the Erection of a \$20,000 School Building at the Village of Alice—Will Buy Typewriters for Business Course.

Sup't Herbert Blair is completing plans for the opening of the school year in Hibbing. The schools will open August 29 this year and there will be a full ten months term. The teaching force this year will number close to 75 and nearly all the members of the corps have already been selected. The increase in the number of teachers is due to the six new location schools at Brooklyn, Kitzville, Poole, Lectoria, Carson Lake and Kelly Lake. These six buildings are now nearly completed and will be ready for the opening of school.

Notices were mailed today by Sup't Blair to all the teachers calling a meeting of teachers for Saturday, Aug. 27 and it is expected that all teachers will be present at this meeting.

One additional location school will be provided for at once. This will be built at the village of Alice, a mile and a half south of Hibbing. The building will be of brick, four rooms and will cost \$20,000. Bids for the construction of this building will be called for at the next meeting of the board which will be held August 24. At the same time bids will be called for the installation of new ventilating systems at the Glen, Penobscot and Stevenson schools to comply with the recommendations of the county superintendent of schools. Bids will also be called for at this meeting for the purchase by the school of nine typewriters for the use of the commercial department which will be inaugurated in the high school this year.
