SCHOOLS WILL BE READY

Contractors Have Until August
20 to Complete New Buildings
—Six More Schools Than Last
Year Approximating \$50,000—
Will Be More.

The Graham-Young contracting company, who have the contract for the building of three of the new schools at the locations will have their work completed for the opening of the school year. The contract time is August 20.

The new schools will not only be convenient for the pupils residing in the different localities, but will eliminate the expense of transporting the pupils in busses as has been necessary. The ride was not very pleasant on some of the cold winter days, especially when the weather was stormy.

The new schools will encourage a regular attendance and it will not be necessary to carry dinners and eat cold lunches.

Altogether there are six of these new educational buildings, Kittzville, Brooklyn, Pool, Kelly Lake, Leetonia and Morton, the latter three being built by E. W. Hallett. The total cost will approximate over \$50,000 and the sites are such as to give good drainage, insuring healthful conditions.

There are several more schools to be built, two have already been voted for, one at Alice and one at the Morris location.

A commendable feature is the fact that these new schools are not temporary structures but substantial and attractive, equaling many similar schools in farming communities of one thousand population.
