Hibbing Historical Society Reopening Plan: Effective June 1, 2021

Masks are to be worn by all staff, patrons and volunteers while in the museum. This policy is defined by the State of Minnesota and local governing bodies, and is in place to protect all people attending the Hibbing Historical Society for any reason. Thank you!

1. Stay home if you are sick or are exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19, such as fever, sore throat, cough, shortness of breath, headache, or nausea/vomiting/diarrhea.
2. Masks are required while in the Hibbing Memorial Building and the Hibbing Historical Society. Disposable masks will be available at the front desk if needed. Anyone not wearing a mask will be asked to leave.
3. Maintain physical distancing.
4. Please utilize hand sanitizer provided at the entrance and around the museum.
5. The normal maximum capacity of the museum is 50 persons. However, at this time, our maximum capacity is 50% of that number - 25 people.
6. Please use main museum entrance door (not staff/office entrance).



The museum is open to all patrons effective June 1, however **appointments are strongly encouraged** so that we can more easily keep our numbers below capacity. We would appreciate appointments for tours, pick-ups, and research questions that require use of our archives.

At this time, if you have articles, photographs, or objects that you wish to donate, **please mail them** rather than bringing them into the museum (if possible). If not, please contact us to schedule an appointment.

Our regular hours are Tuesday – Friday, 10am-2pm. We are also open special hours (evenings and weekends) by appointment only.
